
INTERESTED IN LEARNING ABOUT SURVEYING & MAPPING?



BOK & SWOA BASIC MAPPING & SURVEYING COURSE





A one-day course designed to improve the knowledge and skills of newcomers to surveying and OCAD map drawing.

Timing: 0930 to 1630.

Target Audience: Anyone interested in learning the basics of surveying, and

OCAD drawing. Ideally will have attempted one or two OCAD maps, but still be feeling their way around the program, although complete novices welcomed. Aim is to increase the numbers of orienteers in the south-west willing to create or update maps.

Experienced mappers will have separate interests.

Topics Covered: The contents of the course will be determined by the perceived

needs of those attending, but are likely to include:

Base maps – finding them and using them.

Surveying – techniques for improving efficiency and accuracy **Drawing –** Use of OCAD. Tips for improving efficiency, and

legibility.

Creating final map - Layout, titles, printing

The aim is for the whole day to be as interactive as possible. Although not essential, it would be ideal if registrants could bring a copy of OCAD on a laptop. It may be possible to supply a limited number of laptops to those without appropriate

technology.
